
Based on a review of the material submitted, the following comments apply:

1. Revise the 'If Swallowed' section by adding the word 'immediately' preceding the statement "...for treatment advice."
2. Revise the Storage and Disposal Statements as follows:
 - a. Delete the statement "Do not reuse container but place in trash collection." as this statement is redundant.
 - b. Revise the statement "Offer for recycling..." to read "Offer for recycling if available or place in trash collection."

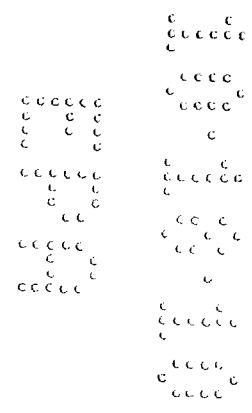

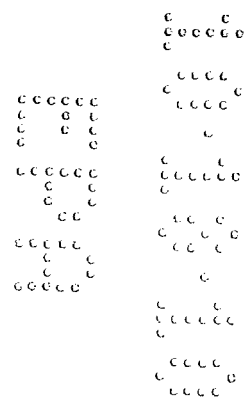

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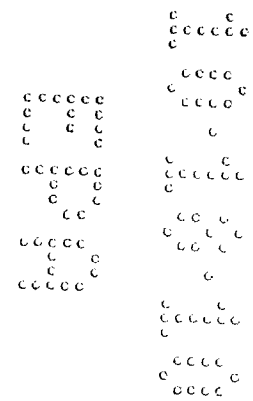
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
