The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Immediately above the "SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING . . ." heading, include the statement "KILLS HIV ON PRE-CLEANED SURFACES - TOILET BOWLS/OBJECTS PREVIOUSLY WASHED WITH FLUORIDE SOAP" in health care settings (Hospitals, Nursing Homes) or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids, and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (associated with AIDS)."
2. Under the "CLEANING PROCEDURES" heading, delete the statement "Follow steps 1 through 3."
3. Change "CONTACT TIME: See step 2 under DISINFECTION AND CLEANING" to read "CONTACT TIME: Leave surface wet for 10 minutes."
4. Revise the statement "1. To clean toilet bowls . . . Flush and rinse out applicator" to read "1. To clean and disinfect toilet bowls . . . Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes. Flush and rinse out applicator."
5. Delete the word "milk."

6. Under "Note to Physician, delete the last sentence beginning with "Measures against circulatory shock . . . may be needed."
7. On the front panel, place the signal word "WARNING" directly below the child hazard warning statement.
8. Revise the referral statement to read:

See reverse side for additional precautionary statements.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. To clean lower bows, remove water from bow by forcing over trap with applicator. Remove excessive water from applicator by pressing it against the side of bowl. Turn 1/2 oz. on applicator. Clean entire unit, especially under rim at water outlets. Flush and rinse out applicator.
2. Hold container six to eight inches from surface to be treated. Spray area until unit is covered with the solution. Allow the product to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. No scrubbing necessary.

Wipe off with a clean cloth or sponge. The product will not leave grit or soap suds.
On heavily soiled areas, remove gross soil before treatment.

ED ALL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV ON SURFACES, OBJECTS SOILED WITH BODY FLUIDS

PERSONAL PROTECTION Disposable latex gloves, gown, mask and splash resistant goggles must be worn when handling or being splashed with blood or body fluids.

CLEANING PROCEDURES: Blood and other body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of this disinfectant. Follow steps 1 through 3.

CONTACT TIME: See step 2 under "DISINFECTION AND
DRAINING"

DISPOSAL OF INFECTIOUS MATERIALS "Blood and other body fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to local regulations for infectious waste disposal."

It produces fungi against *Paratyphlocyba* and other phytophagous insects when used as directed on hard surfaces in the residence. It was found that the conformation of the clean hard non porous surfaces is extremely important to the result.

JO AND MILDEWSTAT Prevents mildew, mold and
mildew on hard and porous materials.

MILDEWSTAT - To control mold and mildew on hard nonporous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops) spray the surfaces to be treated, making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

Designed specifically for institutional cleaning and disinfecting in Nursing Homes, Hospitals, Institutions, Offices, Schools, Motels and Hotels. When used as directed, it will disinfect inanimate hard surfaces (such as walls, sink tops, tables, chairs, telephones, door knobs, light switches, shower stalls, hampers, cabinets and bed springs).

When used as directed, product demonstrates effective disinfection against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella*, *Choleraesuis* and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, thus meeting requirements for hospital use. Efficacy tests have demonstrated it to be an effective one-step cleaner-disinfectant in the presence of organic soil (5% blood serum).

WARNING Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT in case of contact
immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at

least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

PROHIBITIONS • DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER
FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL OPEN
DUMPING IS PROHIBITED

Pesticide Disposal - Pesticide spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal or approved state procedures under Sub title C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

Container Disposal - Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers.
