DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO OPEN CHILD RESISTANT CAP: Use fingernail to pull back and push down rear most ridge on spout. Push spout down following use.

TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT: 1. Remove water from bowl by forcing over trap with applicator. 2. Remove excess water from applicator by pressing it against side of bowl. 3. Pour 1 oz. of Toilet Bowl Cleaner on applicator. 4. Clean entire unit, especially under rim at water outlets. Allow to remain 10 minutes. 5. Flush and rinse out applicator. A preliminary cleaning is necessary for the removal of gross filth prior to disinfection.

DANGER:

Statement of Practical Treatment: Internal: Call a physician immediately. Drink a teaspoonful or more of magnesium chalk, or small pieces of soap softened with water or raw egg white. External: Eyes: Wash with water for 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention. Skin: Wipe off the acid gently. Immediately flood the surface with water, using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesium or baking soda.

Chemical Hazard: Do not use on any surface that can be damaged by acidic materials. Many surfaces are not resistant to acid.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in an area inaccessible to children. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty containers in plastic bag and discard.
