The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

Revise the first paragraph on page 2 as follows:

Change the statement "powerful with this Dow product," to read "Effective with this Dow product".

Change the statement "kill germs" to read "kill many germs".


Add the statement "on hard nonporous surfaces" after E. Coli.

Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamp copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

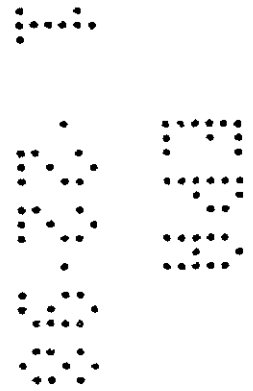

CHILD RESISTANT CAP INSTRUCTIONS: TO OPEN: Push cap down while unscrewing. TO LOCK: Push down and screw cap on tightly.

General Cleaning: Remove cap. Squeeze gently, directing bowl cleaner under rim and on sides of bowl (inside only). Brush clean and flush toilet. Replace cap. Rinse brush with clean water. Do not use on any other surfaces including toilet seat, toilet lid, countertops, tubs and sinks.

To Clean and Disinfect follow these easy steps: 1. Flush first and remove excess dirt and grime before cleaning and disinfecting. 2. Wet all surfaces of bowl interior, including sides of bowl and under the rim, with 6 oz. of liquid. Replace cap securely. 3. Let soak for at least 10 minutes. Do not close toilet bowl lid. 4. Brush entire bowl thoroughly with a bowl brush and flush. 5. Rinse brush in fresh water after use.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Danger: Corrosive. Causes eye and skin damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not breathe vapor or fumes. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling.

First Aid: Immediately: **Eyes:** Rinse immediately with water. Quickly remove contact lenses; then flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. **Swallowed:** Rinse mouth. Drink a glassful of water or milk. Do not induce vomiting. **Skin:** Remove affected clothing. Flush skin with water for 15 minutes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in an area inaccessible to children. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container in plastic bag and discard in trash or rinse thoroughly with water and recycle.
