• Revised Container Disposal Per PR Notice 2007-4


Conditions

Revise label as follows:

- 1) Revise the 1st statement on page one to be in agreement with PR Notice 2000-5 which requires mandatory language y deleting the term, "Recommended". Revise to state: "For use in ..."
- 2) Revise the "Container Disposal" statements for containers greater than 1 gallon to read: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Offer for recycling if available. Otherwise, dispose in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. If burned, stay out of smoke
