For rotary floor machine, mix four (4) ounces of product per gallon, spray on carpet at rate of 200-300 sq. ft. per gallon.

Note: Test color fastness of carpet before use. Apply diluted cleaner to a small concealed spot. Then rub with clean white cloth. If color transfers to cloth or changes, a water base product should not be used.

After cleaning, set carpet pile in one direction with a stiff brush. Place aluminum foil under legs of furniture while carpet is drying. Over-wetting can cause shrinking of carpet. Manufacturer assumes no responsibility for over-wetting or misuse.


