The following requirements to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is hereby subject to the comments listed below. Five (5) copies of the finished label must be submitted.

1. The revised label statement of Formula agrees with the label and is acceptable.
2. According to the revised formulation, this product is cleared under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act for use on food contact surfaces [174.101(b)(1)(C)(7)] with not more than 200 parts per million (ppm) available chlorine and not more than 400 ppm of dodecylbenzene sulfonic acid.
3. Please note that in the ingredient statement on the label, the words Active Ingredient and Inert Ingredients should be aligned to the same margin and the words Active Ingredient should be in the singular.
4. Container disposal instructions should be "Do not reuse empty pouches (containers). Rinse empty pouches (containers) thoroughly with water and discard in trash."

1. Scrape and prewash utensils & glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with D.B.K. Cleaner/Lime Remover - first tank.
3. Rinse with clear, cold water - second tank.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 1/4 oz. to 3 gals. water, provide
available chlorination for an 8 hour shift.
5. Inverse all utensils/glasses for at least 2 minutes or for
specified by governing sanitary code.
6. Place sanitized utensils/glasses on a D.B.K. drain grid
dry. Never use towel.
7. Use D.B.K.'s test strips to assure you're meeting requirements.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area away from contact with other chemicals.
solvents. Rinse empty pouches, (containers) thoroughly with water.
discard them in safe place.
