Insert the signal word "Danger" immediately beneath the child hazard warning "Keep out of reach of children." For the type size requirements for this signal word and child hazard warning, refer to the table on the first page of the enclosed summary of label requirements.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.  
For food contact surfaces Use 1/2 oz. per 1 gal water for over 100 PPM "Free available chlorine"

- 1 This product is designated for use in homes, offices, schools, and restaurants. This product is recommended for use on non-porous inanimate surfaces (e.g. stainless steel, chrome, glass, vinyl).
- 2 Dissolve contents of this packet (1/2 oz.) in one gal cold water, provide 100 (plus) PPM "Free available chlorine"
- 3 Immerse cloths/sponges in, or fill spray bottle with solution prepared in bucket.
- 4 Scrape and wash all surfaces to be sanitized. If necessary, remove all gross food particles and soil by a preflush or prescrub and when necessary preheat treatment.
- 5 Rinse surface with cold clear water.
- 6 Sanitize with cloth, sponge, or spray from bucket of prepared solution. Be sure to wet all surfaces thoroughly.
- 7 Place cloth or sponge back into prepared solution, after use.
- 8 Allow solution to remain on surface for two (2) minutes or contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
- 9 Let your sanitized surface "air dry"
- 10 A fresh solution should be prepared at least daily or more often if solution becomes diluted or soiled.
- 11 Use D.B.K. chlorine test strips to assure that you are meeting local requirements at all times.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area away from contact with other chemicals, solvents. Do not reuse empty pouches, (containers). Rinse empty pouches, (containers) thoroughly with water and discard in trash.
