1 Where to Use:

Exterior application only. Natural Solidtone Oil Stain is richly pigmented and formulated to provide an opaque velvet flat finish that preserves the wood and repels damaging moisture. Apply only to new or previously stained unsealed vertical surfaces such as siding and fences. Not recommended for horizontal surfaces, such as decks. Do not use on abrade a piywood, outdoor furniture or on surfaces which are in direct contact with the ground. Top coating with clears should be avoided as this will seal the surface preventing future stain penetration

2 Frepare the Surface:

The surface to be stained must be clean and dry. Previously unsealed, stained surfaces, should be free of any flaking stain chalk, or dirt.
