HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. May cause irritation of skin, eyes, nose or throat. Avoid breathing dust from treated seed. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under provisions of 30 CFR Part II. Avoid contact with skin by wearing rubber gloves when treating or handling treated seed. Wash with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking. Avoid contamination of feed, food and foodstuffs. Do not consume alcoholic beverages immediately before or within 24 hours after working with AGROSOL Pour-on.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:** If swallowed, induce vomiting by drinking 1 or 2 large glasses of water and then touch back of throat with finger. Get medical attention. If in eyes, flush with clean water for at least 15 minutes and then get medical attention. If on skin, wash with soap and water. Get medical attention if skin irritation persists.

**PRODUCT INFORMATION:** AGROSOL Pour-on when used at the correct rate protects seeds from soil and seed borne diseases that cause damping-off, seed decay, seedling blights, stem canker (Diaporthe phaseolorum Cke. and Ell.) and pod and stem blight (Phomopsis spp) during germination and early seedling stages. AGROSOL Pour-on provides essential molybdenum for plant growth where soils are found to be deficient in available molybdenum.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.**

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**

Apply AGROSOL Pour-on to soybean seed at a rate of 4 fl. oz. per bushel as a planter box application. Mix thoroughly with seed in the planter box as follows:

**For Conventional Plate Planters and MAX-EMERGE<sup>R</sup> Plateless Planters by John Deere -** Pour one bushel of seed into each planter box. Pour enough AGROSOL Pour-on on top of the seed to treat one bushel. Stir thoroughly with an axe handle (purchased and used for this purpose only) until all the seed is uniformly coated. (MAX-EMERGE<sup>R</sup> is a reg. T.M. of Deere and Co.)

**NOTE:** Avoid very deep seeding and exceptionally early sowing under poor growing conditions for maximum benefits. Use only recommended rates. Lower amounts may not give the desired control. Regularly inspect planter plates of seed drill and clean as required.

**Clean-up for Electric Eye Population Monitors:** At the end of each day of use, clean out the electric-eye monitors with brushes provided by the planter manufacturers, according to their directions.

Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seeds beyond planting time.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store above 32°F. Product stored at a lower temperature will reconstitute to satisfactory utility if warmed to approximately 70°F and thoroughly shaken or stirred before use. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store away from water, food and food.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
