DIRECTIONS

FOR BOWL CLEANING:

1. Remove water from bowl by forcing over trap with bowl mop; Press water out of mop.
2. Holding bottle over bowl, apply 2 ounces to mop.
3. Thoroughly clean bowl and rim surfaces.
4. Flush toilet and rinse out mop.

FOR URINAL CLEANING:

1. Holding bottle over urinal, apply 2 ounces to mop.
2. Thoroughly clean urinal including all grooves.
3. Remove screen and pour 2 ounces into drain pipe.
4. Allow to stand three minutes, then swab inside of pipe.
5. Replace screen and flush several times.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT USE ON SINKS, BATH TUBS, OR ANY SURFACE EXCEPT VITREOUS TOILETS AND URINALS.

DANGER-CAUSTIC: May be fatal if swallowed. Produces chemical burns. Do not breath vapor or fumes.

ANTIDOTE

EXTERNAL:

EYES: Do not get in eyes. In case of contact with eye flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists get medical attention.

SKIN: Wipe off acid gently. Immediately flood surface with water, using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.

INTERNAL: Call a physician immediately. Drink a teaspoonful or more of magnesia, chalk, whiting, or small pieces of soap softened with water, in milk, mucilage or raw egg white.
