## KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

### SWIMMING POOLS:

For algae control use one gallon of ALGACIDE to each 50,000 gallons of pool water (T oz. per 390 gallons of water). After first application, add one quart of ALGACIDE to each 50,000 gallons 1¼ oz. per 390 gallons) of water every 5 to 7 days depending on weather. During sunny and humid periods more frequent additions may be required.

Pour the ALGACIDE into the water from various locations around the pool. ALGACIDE will distribute itself. Best results are obtained when pool is cleaned and filled with fresh water after using ALGACIDE.

Where algae is observed add four gallons of ALGACIDE to each 50,000 gallons of pool water. Let stand overnight. The precipitated algae should be removed (by vacuuming), fresh water added to replace the water spent during cleaning and desedimentation and the pool again treated with ALGACIDE by the addition of one gallon to each 50,000 gailons of water every 5 to 7 days.

ALGACIDE, in concentrations recommended for swimming pools, will control algae and is intended to supplement, not replace chlorination.
