Flea Shield™

DIRECTIONS: To control fleas on dogs: remove cap and press down on plastic button. Be sure arrow is pointing away from you. Hold at a convenient distance from the animal—approximately 6 to 8 inches. Brush the pet's hair to a standing position with one hand and follow closely with spray so that spray contacts the skin. Work from the hind quarters of the animal to the head. Keep the spray moving constantly. Spray only long enough to dampen the hair and skin. Do not allow spray to get into eyes or on scrotum. Spray on a basis of 20 to 30 seconds application for a 25 pound dog. Repeat only when fleas reappear, but not more often than once weekly. The spray, as well as the hissing sound may temporarily frighten the pet; however, they normally become accustomed to this treatment.

To control ticks on dogs: apply Flea Shield as for fleas, but make certain each tick is wet with the spray. Do not repeat treatment more frequently than once weekly.

To control fleas and ticks in dog's quarters: spray Flea Shield directly onto bedding, interior of kennel and any cracks or crevices where fleas or ticks may be found. Before using on any easily stained surface, test a small spot before giving full treatment.

WARNING: Use only as directed. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Inhalation to induce intoxication can be fatal. Avoid contact of spray with eyes or clothing. Wash hands with soap and water after handling.

Do not spray toward your pet's face or onto his scrotum. Do not apply to broken, irritated or sensitive skin. If an irritation develops, discontinue use. Avoid contamination of food, utensils and food preparation areas.

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator. **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.**
