Notification of Change in Producing Establishment

Explanation

Due to the closure of our Trenton, NJ plant (EPA Est. 8220-NJ-2), production of ZENOX Flea & Tick Shampoo for Cats and Dogs is being transferred to our Cranbury, NJ facility (EPA Est. 8220-NJ-1). The Carter-Wallace, Inc. address listed in Boxes 2 and 11 of the basic and alternate Confidential Statements of Formula (CSF) dated 2/7/97 (2 original and signed copies of both CSFs enclosed) reflects this change in producing establishment and supplier of deionized water. In addition, there is one other nonsubstantive change: the unit of weight in Boxes 13a and 17 is changed from pounds to kilograms. Copies of the superseded basic and alternate CSFs dated 12/02/94 and accepted 2/22/95 are provided for information.

ZENOX Flea & Tick Shampoo for Cats and Dogs is sold under separate labeling for use on dogs and for use on cats. One copy of each final printed label bearing the revised EPA establishment number is submitted herewith.

Certification

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 95-2 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. 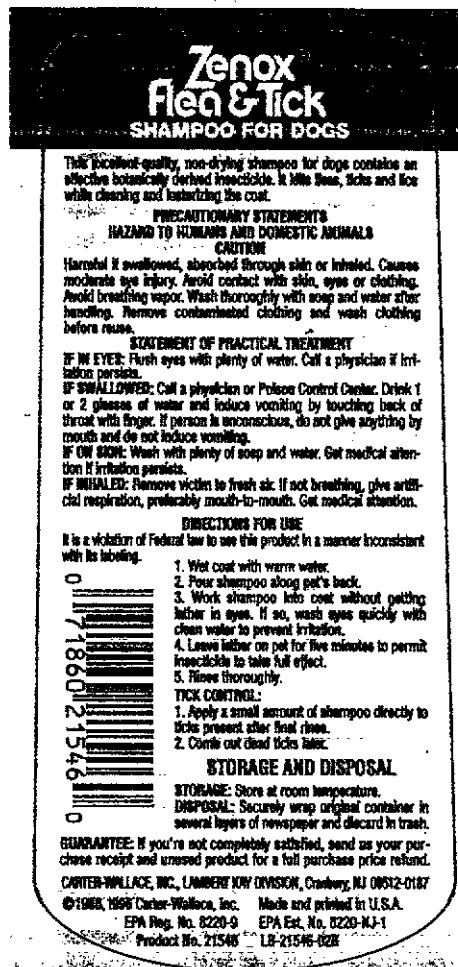
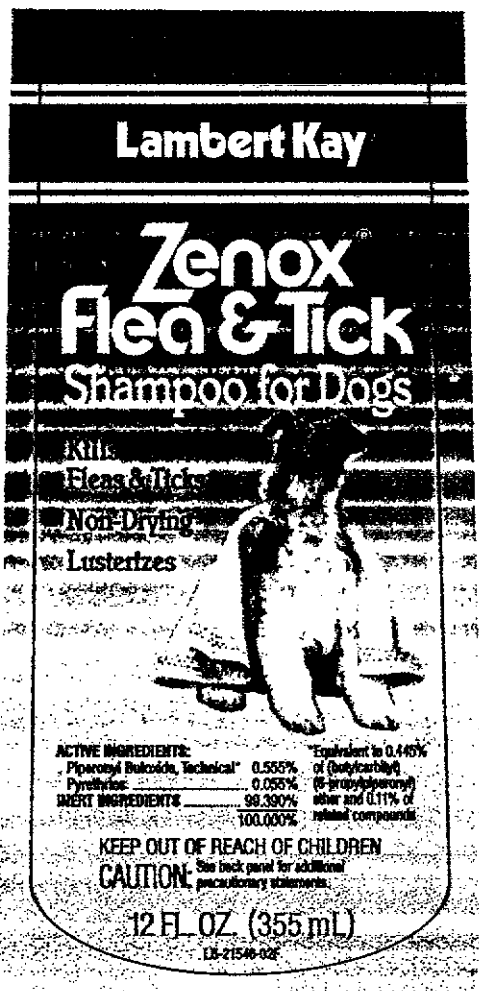
