CLEANING EAR
Insert sufficient EAR-RITE into ear (usually 1/4 oz.) to moisten entire surface. Allow EAR-RITE to soak in for a few minutes, swab ear as clean as possible with cotton.

MEDICATION
After following above cleaning procedure and the ear is clear, insert sufficient EAR-RITE into ear to coat entire surface (usually 10 drops) and allow to remain. Repeat medication procedure once daily until condition is completely corrected. Results should be rapid and improvement should be noticeable after a few days.

DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL, OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.

DO NOT REUSE CONTAINER. DESTROY WHEN EMPTY.

EAR HYGIENE
Clean ears twice a month as an aid in reducing the probability of infestation by ear mites and wax accumulation.
