DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Clean ears twice a month as an
aid in reducing probability of ear
mite infestation and wax accumu-
lation. Instill 10 drops of EAR-
RITE into each ear. Gently
massage base of ear for 3 to 5
minutes. Let soak for a few more
minutes. Then let dog shake its
head to remove as much EAR-
RITE as possible. Swab thor-
oughly with cotton.
