Subject: Victory Flea Soap For Dogs
EPA Registration No. 8220-20
Your Application Dated December 5, 1984

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The child hazard precaution should appear just above the signal word "CAUTION" on the front panel of the label.
2. The ingredients statement should appear on the front panel of the label as per section 162.10 of the Regulations.
3. Add the following to the side panel of the label:

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans

Harmful If Swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes.

4. Propose a statement of practical treatment for oral ingestion and eye contact.
5. Add the statement "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" to the beginning of the use directions.
6. Add the following disposal text to the label:

Disposal

Wrap package and unused product and dispose in trash.
