The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 2(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments:

1. Change the phrase "Other Cube Resins" in the ingredients statement to "Other Associated Resins."
2. Add the statement "Do not use on puppies less than 4 weeks old" to the use directions.
3. Change the If In Eyes section of the Statement of Practical Treatment to read "Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists."
4. Add the statement "Get medical attention if irritation persists" to the If On Skin statement.
5. Comply with the requirements of the Rotenone Registration Standard.

Saturate dog's coat thoroughly for several minutes and dry without rinsing. Repeat when necessary. To kill lice on long-haired dogs, bathe first with soap and water. Rinse out soap. Then use VICTORY Insecticide Dip solution as a final rinse. **Buyer assumes all risks of use, storage or handling of this product not in strict accordance with directions given herewith.**
