

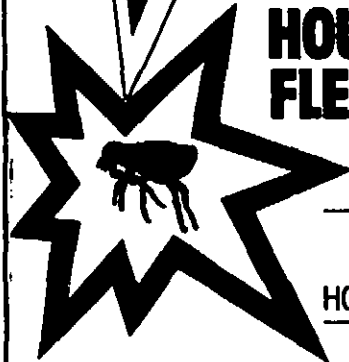

**HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**  
**CAUTION: HAZARD TO HUMANS.** Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs, and domestic water supplies. Wash thoroughly after handling. May be harmful if swallowed.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARD**  
 Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**  
**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF ON SKIN:** In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water. **IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water.  
**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine only by injection is an antidote.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
 It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not treat pets with this product. To control the source of pest infestation, pets inhabiting the treated areas should be treated separately with flea- and tick-control products registered for application to pets.

For control of fleas and brown dog ticks, spot spray on areas where these pests may be present, such as floors, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pet's bedding, cracks and crevices, baseboards, and window and door frames. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Tests have shown the product will not stain most fabrics or rugs.

**VICTORY® Household Flea & Tick Killer** has residual activity and keeps working for weeks after application. Repeat the treatment as needed.

**VICTORY Household Flea & Tick Killer** will also control the following pests: ants, carpet beetles, clover mites, cockroaches, crickets, sawflies, firebrats, flies, mosquitoes, silverfish, and spiders.

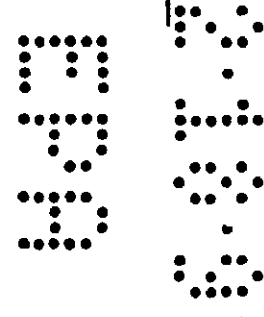
