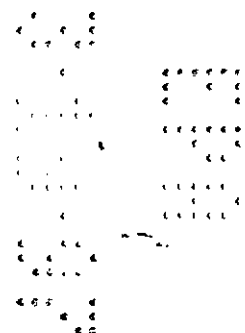
Explanation

Production of VICTORY Household Flea & Tick Killer is being transferred from Speer Products, Inc. (EPA Est. 11715-TN-1) to our Cranbury, NJ facility (EPA Est. 8220-NJ-1). The Carter-Wallace, Inc. address listed in Boxes 2 and 11 of the basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated 3/14/97 (2 original and signed copies enclosed) reflects this change in producing establishment and supplier of deionized water. In addition, there is one other nonsubstantive change: the unit of weight in Boxes 13a and 17 is changed from pounds to kilograms. A copy of the superseded basic CSF dated 2/15/94 and accepted 4/12/94 is provided for information.

Labeling on the first batch of product made in Cranbury will bear the previously submitted alternate name LASSIE Household Flea & Tick Killer. One copy of final printed labeling is submitted herewith.

Certification

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 95-2 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 95-2 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: HAZARD TO HUMANS. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs, and domestic water supplies. DIRECTIONS FOR USE. It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not treat pets with this product. To control the source of pest infestation, pets inhabiting the treated areas should be treated separately with flea- and tick-control products registered for application to pets. For control of fleas and brown dog ticks, spot spray on areas where these pests may be present, such as floors, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pet's bedding, cracks and crevices, baseboards, and window and door frames. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Tests have shown the product will not stain most fabrics or rugs. LASSIE Household Flea & Tick Killer has residual activity and keeps working for weeks after application. Repeat the treatment as needed. LASSIE Household Flea & Tick Killer will also control the following pests: ants, carpet beetles, clover mites, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, firebrats, flies, mosquitoes, silverfish, and spiders. **CAUTION:** Do not apply sprays of this product in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes, or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use in poultry houses or other animal buildings. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs, and water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food-handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product. Leave treated areas and do not return for at least one hour. Do not allow children or pets to walk on treated surfaces until they are completely dry. Remove pets and cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL. STORAGE: Keep from freezing. Do not store below 32°F. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
