DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove cap. Holding can upright, point nozzle in direction spray is desired. From a distance of 6 to 12 inches, press down button and spray evenly over dog or cat until coat is slightly damp. Do not spray in face; avoid eyes. On heavily coated animals, ruffle the coat and spray against the lay of the hair. Use spray on the basis of 20 to 30 seconds for a 25 pound dog and 4 to 6 seconds for a 5 pound cat. Spray directly on ticks. Spray bedding, interior of kennels and other places where fleas and ticks are found. Tests have shown one spraying will kill fleas up to 21 days. Heavy infestation may require more frequent spraying but not more than once a week. Do not use on pregnant dogs. Do not apply to rugs, drapes and other fabrics.

CAUTION

Harmful if absorbed through the skin. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 4 weeks of age. Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water, get medical attention if irritation persists.
