Hazards to Humans (and Domestic Animals)

CAUTION: Concentrate is harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

Do not use on bitches nursing puppies or pups under three (3) months old or cats. Note to Physician and Veterinarian: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine by injection is antidotal only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Give a glass of milk or water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Never give anything by mouth to, or induce vomiting in, an unconscious or convulsing person.

If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If on Skin: Wash off with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is in violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. Stir four (4) tablespoonsful (two fl. oz.) into one (1) gallon of water. Dip, sponge or swab dog with this emulsion until thoroughly wet. If dipping, avoid submersion of dog's nose and mouth. Dog handlers should wear rubber gloves while dipping dogs or otherwise coming into contact with the use concentration. Dipping should be limited to no more than 30 seconds. Allow dog to dry in warm place without rinsing or toweling. Repeat application in 21 day intervals as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL DIRECTIONS

Keep tightly sealed. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse container thoroughly before discarding. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
