Also, we have deleted the term "for Cats" in the product name since the product is not used on cats.
3. A brief description of the formulation process must be provided.
4. The flame extension must be given for this product.

This product will kill fleas up to 14 days and ticks up to 7 days on dogs.

Do not use this product on cats.

Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. Fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly. Do not spray in face, eyes or on genitalia. Repeat as needed.

Apply at the rate of two seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short haired dogs and up to eight seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long haired dogs.
