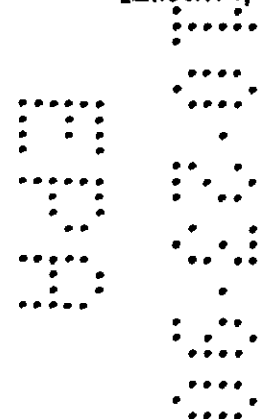

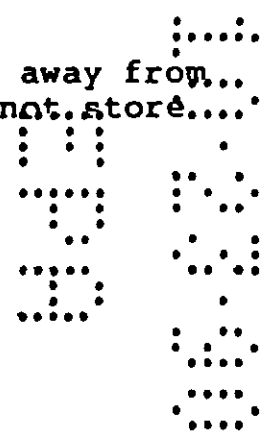

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply sprays of this product in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use in poultry houses or other animal buildings. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs and water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product. Leave treated areas and do not return for at least one hour. Do not allow children or pets to walk on treated surfaces until they are completely dry. Remove pets and cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Do not store below 32°F.



STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. To control the source of pest infestation, pets inhabiting the treated areas should be treated separately with flea and tick control products registered for application to pets.

For control of fleas and brown dog ticks, spot spray on areas where these pests may be present such as floors, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pets bedding, cracks and crevices, baseboards and window and door frames. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Tests have shown the product will not stain most fabrics or rugs. Before spraying extensive areas of rugs, fabrics or plastics, test the effect of this product by first treating a small inconspicuous area.

X-O-TROL Flea and Tick Household Spray will also control the following pests: ants, carpet beetles, clover mites, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, firebrats, flies, mosquitoes, silverfish, spiders.
