The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comment listed below:

- 1. Include the following statement in the **Environmental Hazards** section: "Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate."
- 2. Submit three copies of final printed labeling prior to 'releasing the product for shipment.

Regarding Springborn Laboratories' discussions with EPA's toxicologist regarding the dermal sensitization study, this type of communication is improper. All future communications and concerns with Agency reviews of submitted data must be sent through the product management team. The Agency has reviewed the submitted responses, however, and has determined that the product is not a borderline sensitizer and, therefore, does not need to be labeled as such.
