

**INSECT CONTROL** Roses, Dahlias, Chrysanthemums, Carnations, Asters, Geraniums, Azaleas, Gladiolus, Camellias, Delphiniums, Begonias and other ornamentals for Aphids, Thrips, Red Spiders, Ants, Lace bugs, Mealybugs, Whitefly, Rose Leafhoppers.

**PLANT DISEASE CONTROL** For Blackspot and Powdery Mildew on Roses.

**Directions for above Pests and Plant Diseases:**

Hold jet 18 to 24 inches from plant. **NO CLOSER.** Apply as a light dry spray. Do not wet plants to a visible deposit. Spray about one foot of plant per second in sweeping motion or spray short spurts at intervals. Be sure to contact upper and lower surfaces of leaves. For best results, apply before insects or diseases appear. Apply preferably in the evening or early morning when the air is still. Do not apply during heat of day or in direct sunlight. Apply at 7 to 10 day intervals. Do not apply to wet plants. **TO OPERATE JET:** Remove cap. Hold jet in upright position and press nozzle directing spray at insects and upper and lower leaf.

**CAUTION:** May be absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly after using. Do not breathe vapor or spray liquid on skin. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use on household pets or humans harmful if swallowed. Do not use indoors or in confined areas. Keep out of reach of children. Do not use in combination with or closely following oil sprays. Do not use on Boston, Maidenhair and Peteris and some species of Crassula.
