READ ENTIRE LABEL. Use strictly in accordance with label cautions, warnings and directions, and in conformity with Federal & State regulations.

Shake well. Spray thoroughly. Be sure to cover under side of leaves and branches.

DORMANT SEASON: For Scale Insects, Mealy Bugs and Mite Eggs on dormant deciduous shrubs and trees USE: 1/3 Pint (11 tablespoonfuls) per gallon of water. On evergreens use 1/4 pt. (8 tablespoonfuls) per gallon of water.

GROWING SEASON: For Red Spider Mites, Mealy Bugs, White Flies and Scale Insects (young) USE: 5 tablespoonfuls (2 1/2 oz.) per gallon of water, OR USE: 2 tablespoonfuls (1 oz.) PLUS 2 teaspoonfuls SEARS 50% MALATHION per gallon of water.

CAUTION: Wash hands after use. Do not use within 30 days of spraying sulphur. Avoid spraying when temperature is exceedingly high or when plants are suffering from drought. Oil Sprays should not be applied to broad-leaf evergreens or palms when freezing or near freezing temperatures may be expected within 3 weeks of spray application. Do not use on maidenhair ferns, cocos palms. Do not use on non-woody plants unless specified. Oil sprays may cause discoloration to Blue Spruce.
