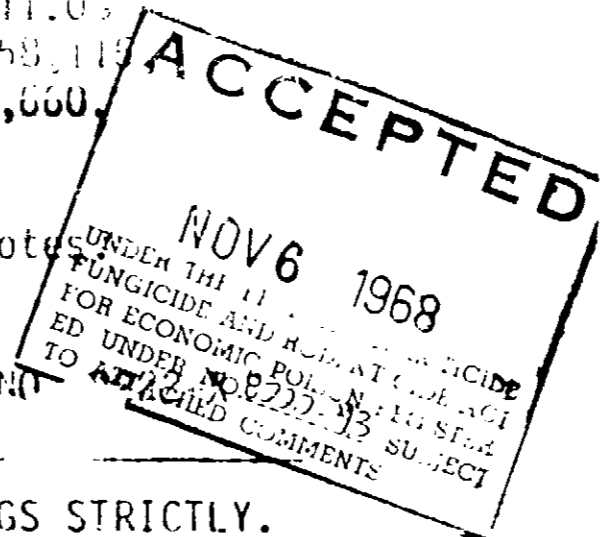
FRUIT and VEGETABLE FUNGICIDE

FOR: Apples, Peaches, Grapes, Pine Berries, Strawberries, Melons, Vegetables.

BACK PANEL: READ ENTIRE LABEL. FOLLOW DIRECTIONS AND WARNINGS STRICTLY.

USE 2 tablespoonfuls (1 oz.) per gallon of water for general spraying. For heavy mite infestations repeat spray after 5 days; on this repeat application the dosage can be reduced to 1 oz. in 1 1/2 gallons of water. NET ALL PART OF THE PLANT THOROUGHLY.

Repeat as needed except for limitations noted on crops below.

CROPS	PESTS	TIME AND LIMITATIONS
BLACKBERRIES BOYSENBERRIES LOGANBERRIES RASPBERRIES	Aphids, mites, leafhoppers, leaf rollers.	Apply as needed, but not within 14 days of harvest.
	Root borers and weevils.	Drench soil at base 7-10 days before bloom.
STRAWBERRIES	Aphids, mites, leaf rollers, leaf tiers, root weevils.	Apply as needed, but not within 5 days of harvest. Drench soil for weevils.
FILBERTS (Oregon-Wash.)	Aphids, mealybug, leaf- roller, filbert worm	Do not apply within 30 days of harvest.
PECANS	Aphids, mites, webworm, pecan case bearer	Do not apply after husks split.
WALNUTS	Aphids, mites, codling moth, walnut husk fly.	Apply when nuts are size of peas and 6 weeks before harvest (not after husks split).
ON VEGETABLES spray young plants when they have 4 or 5 true leaves. Repeat as needed within listed limitations.		
ARTICHOSES	Plume moth	Not within 30 days of harvest.
BEANS	Aphids, mites, leafhoppers, leafrollers, worms, beetles.	Not within 7 days of harvest on snap beans. On dry beans spray not more than 4 times and not within 30 days of harvest.
BRUSSELS SPROUTS	Aphids, worms, loopers	Do not spray closer to harvest than 7 days Brussels Sprouts;
BROCCOLI	Root Maggot: Use 2 oz. per pt. water & drench soil with	15 days Broccoli & Cauliflower;
CABBAGE	1/2 cup around each transplant	21 days Cabbage.

CUCUMBER	Beetles	Not over 3 times per season nor within 6 days of harvest.
EGGPLANTS	Beetles, leafminers	Not within 14 days of harvest.
CUCUMBERS (dry Only)	thrips	Not within 28 days of harvest.
PEPPERS	Leafminer, flea beetles, European corn borer.	Not over 4 times per season nor within 5 days of harvest.
	Aphids, fleahoppers, Leafhoppers, spittle bugs, leafminers, tuberworms, Colorado potato beetles, European corn borer, tarnished plant bugs.	Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
POTATOES		
SPINACH	Aphids, leaf miners, mites.	Not within 14 days of harvest.
TOMATOES	Aphids, flea beetles, worms, leafhoppers, thrips, grasshoppers.	Thorough coverage when fruit is starting to set will reduce the need for later sprays.

C A U T I O N: Do not pasture animals in sprayed areas for 21 days after last application. Do not feed plant residues to animals.
Do not apply to plants which are not well irrigated or when temperatures exceed 90°F. within 4 hours before or after spraying.

P E A R L D I P H T E R I C A C I D: May be Fatal if Swallowed, Inhaled or Absorbed Through the Skin.
Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear rubber gloves, protective clothing
and goggles. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after use.
