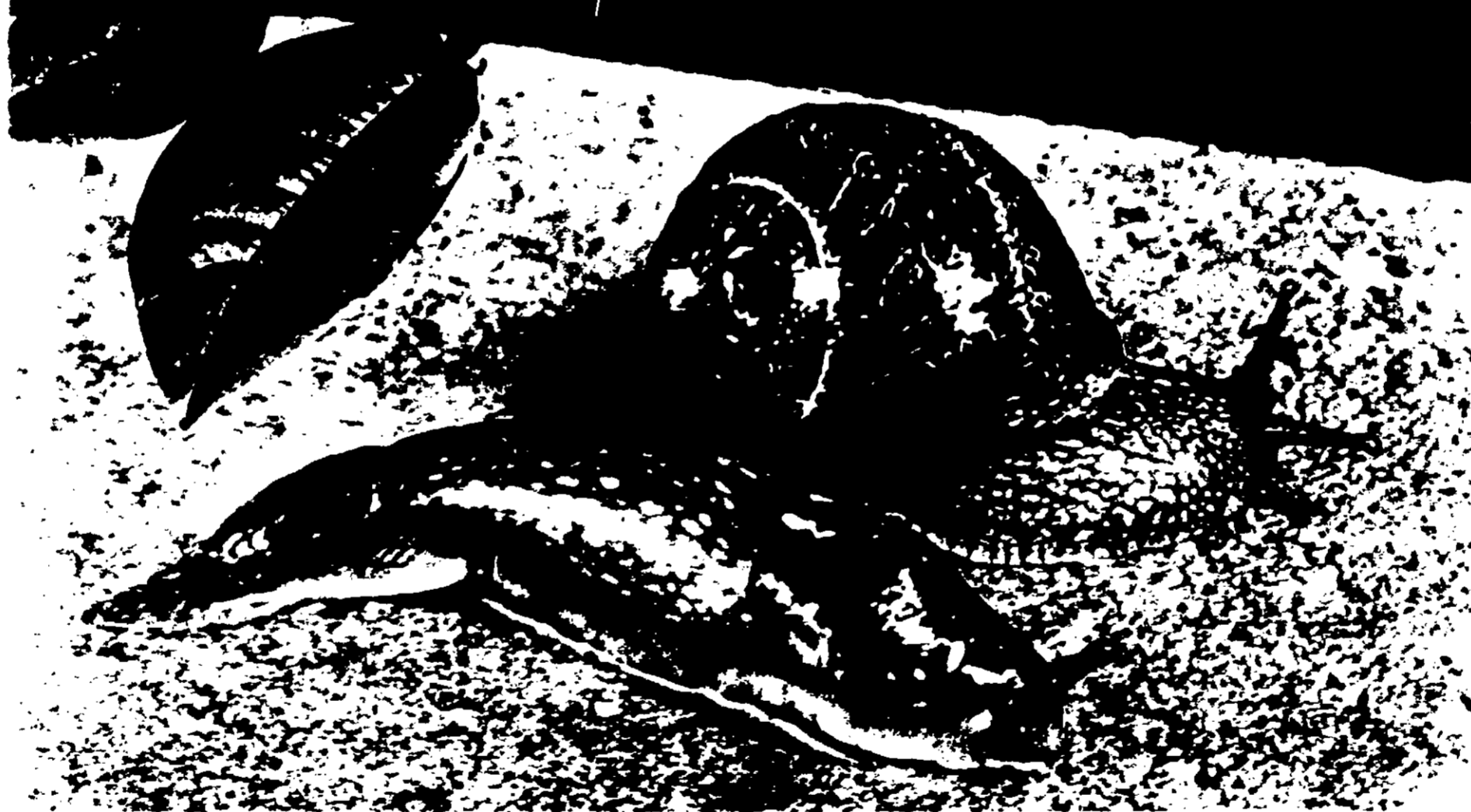

WARNING

Pets and domestic animals may be attracted to this bait. Care should be taken to keep these animals out of treated areas. Avoid contamination of feed, foodstuffs, water supply, streams and ponds. Do not apply within 6 days of harvest to any food crop.

Plants feeding on treated areas may be killed.

Do not apply to any area not specified on the label. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift of dust from areas treated.

PLANT SPECIMENS:

Feeding plants can also be treated with a thin line of bait for protection. But care should be exercised to avoid contaminating edible parts.

Night or evening feeding slugs and snails are two of the most common and destructive garden pests. Proper use of T & C SNAIL & SLUG KILLER will control these pests in your flowers, garden and lawn. METALDEHYDE is the killing agent in this slug bait and is more effective than most other slug killers with its 4% Metaldehyde content.

Wash equipment and containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Containers should be disposed by burying with vent holes by burning (keep out of smoke.)

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply 100 lbs. per acre or 12 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. to control snails and slugs, on soil surface around plants. Do not contaminate edible parts. For use

STRAWBERRIES: Apply 100 lbs. per acre to control snails & slugs. Do not apply within 6 days of harvest.

The area to be treated should be damp. The method of applying will vary with the conditions; i.e. many small heaps of about 1 tablespoonful can be placed in a flower garden, a large garden may be covered by sprinkling material throughout the garden area, or the material may be spread in a thin line along a border of an adjacent area of infestation.
