DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake well before use. For use protective use. A fine spray being away from people. Fluoridation.

INDOORS - FOR HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS

Close windows and doors. Fill nozzle slowly, direct the spray at folds, parts of the ceiling, especially windows and trim. Wait about 15 minutes. Then, if the room is small, the ceiling of the treated area may be closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is complete.

INDOORS - FOR CRAWLING INSECTS

Residual spray, gaps, crevices, cracks, splinters, etc. in wood, especially in the areas such as closets, basements, and stables, and in pipes, drains, and refrigerators, in attics, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS - Spray in nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - TO KILL FLYING INSECTS

Spray areas infested with house flies, gnats, mosquitoes, house flies, biting flies, and flying ants. Mixes. Mix with water in a spray container. Hold container 15 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes, and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 1.5 seconds per 100 sq ft of space. The spraying is for the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios with a residual spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

Use on plants infested with white flies, leafhoppers, plant bugs, spittlebugs, Japanese beetle, and other insects. Spray on plants with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 1.5 seconds per 100 sq ft of space. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios with a residual spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

Use on plants infested with aphids, scale insects, Japanese beetle, and other insects. Spray on plants with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 1.5 seconds per 100 sq ft of space. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios with a residual spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

OUTDOORS - TO CONTROL NUISANCE PETS

ANTS - Spray in nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FLIES - Direct short burst of spray on insects and repeat as necessary.

WASPS - Application should be made immediately when insects are at least. Spray directly into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.
