CAUTION:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Cover or remove fishbowls. Do not use on edible crops. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not expose container to temperatures above 120°F. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DO NOT SPRAY ON HUMANS OR ANIMALS. DO NOT SPRAY ON EDIBLE CROPS OR FOODSTUFFS.

INDOORS - FLYING INSECTS, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS

Open windows and doors. Spray about 1/2 pint of insecticide on walls, ceiling, floor, furniture, curtains, etc. If there are no windows, spray within st. the room. Seal the treated area from the outside for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is complete.

OUTDOORS - TO CONTROL INSECTS

Re-enter treated areas 15 minutes after spraying. Spray on surfaces such as corners, edges, nooks, ledges around pipes & fixtures, in refrigerators, freezers, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS - Spray nests, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - TO KILL FLYING INSECTS

Re-enter treated area with tongs, traps, gnats,苍蝇, house flies, biting flies, and flying ants. Thoroughly spray walls and ceiling above head, corners, ledges, curtains, and glassy areas. Spray traps with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1/2 to 1 1/2 pints per cubic yard of space containing gnats, house flies. The rate may vary. These flying insects will open their wings in flight and remain only when the air is still. A low spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

Re-enter treated area with white flies, earwigs, caterpillars, aphids, Japanese beetle, Colorado potato beetles, scales, hornets, spiders, wasps, ticks, thrips, European corn borer, leafhoppers, leafminers, aphids, caterpillars, etc. Spray on stems, leaves, buds, flowers, blossoms, and twigs of ornamental plants at the rate of 1/2 to 1 1/2 pints per cubic yard of the plant area. Repeat as necessary. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

PLANTS - To control aphids, snapdragons, night-ashes, chrysanthemums, marigolds, sunflowers, tobacco, velvet grass, and leafy acids. Re-enter treated area with white flies, earwigs, caterpillars, aphids, spiders, wasps, ticks, thrips, European corn borer, Colorado potato beetles, etc. Spray as directed above.

CATERPILLARS - To control, mulberry, oak, hornbeam, Ash, lime, maple, birch, pine, cedar, spruce, fir, larch, and Douglas fir. Re-enter treated area with caterpillars. Spray as directed above.

OUTDOORS - TO PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS

ANTS - Spray nests, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - TO CONTROL NUISANCE PESTS

ANTS - Spray nests, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FLIES - Direct a burst of spray on surfaces and repeat as necessary.

WASPS - Application should be made in the evening when insects are at rest. Spray on any surface which insects contact as far as possible. Repeat as necessary.
