Algaecide 10

In swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of Algaecide 10 fluid ounces of Algaecide 10 to move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Algaecide 10 per 10,000 gallons should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 8 to 12 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially Algaecide 10 per 1,000 gallons of 1 to 3 fluid ounces of Algaecide 10 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

Algaecide 10 is compared to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains with alkaline pH. Algaecide 10 is compared to decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and disposed of with clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container.
