

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ALGAECIDE 40

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and innumerable effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of ALGAECIDE 40 fluid ounces of ALGAECIDE 40 to 10 to 18 fluid ounces of pool add initially 10 to 18 fluid ounces of ALGAECIDE 40 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of ALGAECIDE 40 per 10,000 gallons 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 2 to 3 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 1 fluid ounce of ALGAECIDE 40 per 1,000 gallons of 0.4 to 1 fluid ounces of ALGAECIDE 40 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

ALGAECIDE 40 is compatible with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products. ALGAECIDE 40 is compatible with alkaline pH. ALGAECIDE 40 is compatible with decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and other chemicals normally required. However, do not mix ALGAECIDE 40 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and stored with clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of contents and container as directed.
