STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED-Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

IF INHALED- Remove victim to fresh air immediately. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES- Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 10 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.

IF ON SKIN- Remove contaminated clothing immediately and wash affected area with soap and water. Call a physician immediately. Wash clothing before re-use.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN-WARNING SYMPTOMS: Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pin-point pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps.

TREATMENT: Atropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation, atropine sulfate should be injected at 10 minute intervals, in doses of 1 to 2 milligrams, until complete atropinization has occurred.

Pralidoxime chloride (2-PAM chloride) may also be used as an effective antidote in addition to and while maintaining full atropinization. In adults, an initial dose of 1 gram of 2-PAM should be injected, preferably as an infusion in 250cc of saline over a 15 to 30 minute period. If this is not practical, 2-PAM may be administered slowly by intravenous injection in a 5 percent solution in water over not less than two minutes. After about an hour, a second dose of 1 gram of 2-PAM will be indicated. If muscle weakness has not been relieved. For infants and children the dose of 2-PAM is 0.25 grams.

Morphine is contraindicated.

Clear chest by postural drainage. Oxygen administration may be necessary. Observe patient continuously for 48 hours. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may, without warning, cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until cholinesterase reactivation has been attained as determined by blood test.
