APPLICATION

MECO MICROBIOCIDE 74 is used to inhibit the growth of algae in recirculating commercial and industrial cooling water systems. Before treatment with MECO MICROBIOCIDE 74 systems must be cleaned to remove algae growth and other deposits. Then the system should be treated with an initial slug addition of 5.3 to 8.0 fluid ounces of MECO MICROBIOCIDE 74 per 1,000 gallons of water in the system. Repeat the initial dosage until control is evident. Subsequent slug additions of 4.0 to 8.0 fluid ounces of MECO MICROBIOCIDE 74 per 1,000 gallons of water should be made every 1 to 5 days or as needed. The required frequency of treatment depends on the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions of MECO MICROBIOCIDE 74 should be made to the sump of water cooling towers.

WARNING KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. If swallowed, call a physician immediately. Give patient doses of powdered charcoal immediately or all he can swallow of raw egg whites, milk, gruel, or flour and water.
