

Where infestation is severe, heavy bird* traffic may flatten repellent. In these instances make a second application immediately.

Repellent can be removed with napthalor powder type cleaning agent available at drug stores.

4-THE-BIRDS is a transparent, sticky compound which, when applied to ledges and sills, will discourage birds* from roosting or returning to these covered areas.

This product remains tacky at 15°F and will not run up to 200°F.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS - 80% POLYBUTENE INACTIVE INGREDIENTS - 20%

DIRECTIONS: Surface must be clean and dry to assure adhesion of repellent! Clean by wiping or scraping all dust, dirt, loose paint, droppings, etc. On porous surfaces such as stone or unpainted wood, surface must be sealed by brushing on one coat of shellac or a 50% solution of white glue. After coating has dried, apply repellent with a caulking gun or putty knife. Properly applied bead looks like this

Ledges or sills...apply about 1 inch in from edge in strips "in diameter. Press against sill to get good adhesion and leave occasional gaps for rain water to drain.

Roofs, peaks, cornices, etc... apply ½" diameter bead along highest point. Press against surface to insure good adhesion. 1 gallon applied in ½" x ½" bead will cover approximately 200 lineal feet. DO NOT APPLY LARGER DIAMETER BEADS OF REPELLENT.
