Kills most Staph. and Strep. organisms, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Salmonella choleraesuis and Trichophyton interdigitale (athlete's foot fungi) on surfaces such as bathroom and shower room floors, bathtubs, bath mats or other surfaces commonly contacted by the bare feet. For Surfaces: This product is for disinfection of previously cleaned, hard, non-porous surfaces which are thoroughly moistened by the spray and allowed to remain for a contact time of 10 minutes.

For Deodorizing the Air: Direct spray upwards toward center of room for 3 to 5 seconds.

For Household Use: See use directions under "Surfaces". Kitchens--Sinks drainboard, cabinets, stove and refrigerator, empty garbage cans and under sinks. Controls household odors and retards their return. Bathrooms--Bathtub, wash basin, toilet seat, empty hampers, tiled walls. Controls bathroom odors. General Use--Telephone, pet animal areas, diaper pails, nursery room.

Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
