1. Spray surface until moist.
 2. Repeat application in 14 days to maintain control.
 3. Best results in dry dock only.

PRECAUTIONS (P001): Hazard to humans and domestic animals. **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Have this product container or label with you when seeking a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.
