DIRECTIONS FOR USE
For a wide range of Federal law uses, this product is a general household disinfectant.
1. Shake well before using.
2. Turn on faucet and allow water to run.
3. Hold can upright or upside down to 90 degrees from surface to be cleaned. When spraying, spray down and spray along. Spray upright for a few seconds, then spray quickly down again.
4. Allow time to "soak" in. Wipe off with a clean cloth or paper towel if needed.
5. When using in a confined space, use with good ventilation.

FOR USE TO PREVENT MOLD AND MILDEW

1. Spray on as directed.
2. Repeat application in 14 days when necessary.
3. Repeat monthly thereafter.

FIRST AID STATEMENTS

If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR ON CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.**

Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
