CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. MAR-V-CIDE is recommended for use in barber shops and beauty shops. For disinfecting, a pre-cleaning step is required. Mix one tablespoon of MAR-V-CIDE in one quart of water, or make stock solution by mixing two ounces (1/4 cup) MAR-V-CIDE in one gallon of water. To disinfect inanimate hard surfaces such as floors, walls, cabinets, sinks, counter tops, tables, chairs, and telephones; use two ounces of MAR-V-CIDE per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes. Apply liquid with a mop, sponge, cloth, or bowl mop to thoroughly wet the surfaces. For disinfecting, remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits, then thoroughly wet surface. After application, be sure to rinse thoroughly.

INSTRUMENTS AND TOOLS: Thoroughly clean combs, brushes, scissors, clipper blades, razors, manicure implements and other non-porous instruments prior to complete immersion for 10 minutes (or as required by local authorities). Rinse thoroughly and dry before use.

Fresh solution should be prepared daily or more often if solution becomes diluted or soiled. Dilute only as needed.

FIRST AID
