# Additive Q

## Cutting and Grinding Fluid Bacteriostat

**DIRECTIONS:** Additive Q is recommended for use in water based cutting and grinding fluid mixes to remove objectionable odors caused by bacterial growth. Remove plastic bag, submerge 2-lb. cloth bag of Additive Q no less than 2 feet below surface in 1000 gallons of mix, and then tie string to reservoir. When Additive Q is completely dissolved (12-24 hrs.) remove the cloth bag and properly dispose of it. For continued control, same dosage additions may be made on a weekly basis.
