DIRECTION FOR USE

GENERAL DISINFECTION AND SANITIZATION:

After cleaning, apply a solution containing 1 ounce of Calco-Clean per gallon of water. To disinfect in contagious disease areas, use two ounces per gallon of water. Apply liberally with cloth or sponge to all surfaces.

TEMPORARY DEODORANT FOR SMALL SEPTIC HOLDING TANKS IN TRAILER AND BOATS:

Add 5 ounces of Calco-Clean for each four gallons of water capacity. For holding periods of longer than five days, add additional material as needed.

MOLD CONTROL ON WALLS, CEILINGS:

Clean surfaces thoroughly, rinse, then spray on or sponge on a solution of Calco-Clean diluted two ounces to one gallon of water.

Do not mix with soap or synthetic detergents.
