

**APPLICATION:** Use 4 ounces per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. For disinfecting, remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits, then thoroughly wet surfaces. Versatile and can be applied with a mop, sponge or cloth as well as soaking. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty. Rinsing is not necessary on floor surfaces unless floors are to be waxed or polished.

**FLOOR & WALL CLEANER:** For use in federally inspected meat & poultry plants as a floor & wall cleaner in all departments. To disinfect first remove or expel over the inner trap the residual bowl water prior to applying the use dilution. Use 4 ounces of concentrate and brush the hard surfaces. Close cap container after use.
