CLARKE ULV MOSQUITOCIDE 731 is formulated for use in cold aerosol fog generators, such as the LECO MINI ULV, the LECO ULV MODEL HD, or a back-pack sprayer such as the Kioritz DM-9, which produce a mist having a mass median diameter of 17.0 microns with most of its particles in the 5 to 50 micron range.

This product is intended for use in mosquito adulticiding programs involving residential and recreational areas, swamps, marshes, overgrown waste areas and roadsides where adult mosquitoes are present in annoying numbers. Treat shrubbery and vegetation where mosquitoes may rest. Shrubby and vegetation around stagnant pools, marshy areas, and swamps may be treated. Application of this product to any body of water is prohibited.

CLARKE MOSQUITOCIDE 731 is a ready to use concentrate. It should be applied by truck mounted LECO ULV, MODEL HD, the hand pulled LECO MINI II or portable hand carried or backpack ULV units without further dilution. Nozzle pressure should be 3 PSI for HD units and 1.5 PSI for the Mini II and portable units.

Repeat applications as needed to obtain the desired reduction in adult mosquito population.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- PROHIBITIONS**
Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.
- STORAGE**
Store in a cool, dry place away from open flame. Replace caps or bungs tightly to insure no exposure to moisture or sunlight. If container is punctured or spilled, contain spill with earthen type material and contact manufacturer immediately. Store in original container only. Do not store where confusion may occur resulting in cross-contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food or feed. Store in locked area.
