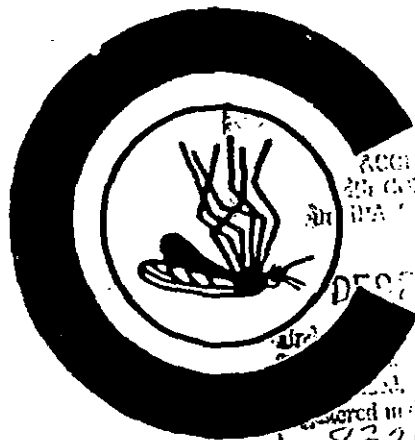

METHO

Apply DURSBAN® 1% G to lawns and other ornamental areas using any hand or mechanical sprayer designed for application. First application should be made before insects first appear using 0.5 lb. per acre. To help obtain required amount of product at a right angle. Immediate watering to wash the zone of insect infestation. 1300 gallons of water per acre. Amounts of DURSBAN® 1% G are shown in table. Re-treat as necessary.
