Apply the product undiluted at a flow rate of 3.00 to 18.00 fluid ounces per minute and an aver-'enicle speed of 10 mph. If a different vehicle speed is used, adjust rate accordingly. Thes equivalent to .00088 to .005 pounds of Permethrin and .0044 to .0264 pounds of Preeronvi Butoxide per acre. Vary flow rate according to vegetation density and mosquito population. Use higher flow rate in heavy vegetation or when populations are high. An accurate flow meter must be used to ensure the proper flow rate. For proper application, mount the fog applicator so that the nozzle is at least 41/2 feet above ground level and directed out the back of the vehicle.
