On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/Cite all data required for registration /reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data, and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes before you release this product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase EPA Registration Number "EPA Reg. No. 8329-35."
- b. Delete the following statements from the center panel of the labeling: "Avoid breathing mist, May be Fatal If Swallowed, Causes Eye Irritation, etc..."
- c. Revise the precautionary statement to read as follow:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Wash thoroughly after handling. Remove and wash clothing before reuse.

- d. The environmental hazards statement must be revised to read as follow:

This product is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Drift and runoff treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not allow spray treatment to drift on pastureland, cropland, poultry ranges or water supplies. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively visiting the treatment area.

- e. The statement of practical treatment must be revised to read as follow:

Harmful If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

A statement of practical treatment for the ocular route of exposure is not required due to the low toxicity exhibited, however, if you decide to include the "If In Eyes" statement, it should read as follow:

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

- f. Refer to PR Notices 84-1 or 83-3 for appropriate "Container and Disposal Statement."
- g. Add an application rates chart under the subheading "Conditions and Rates to Use For Mosquito Control." The chart should give the instructions for usage of pounds/acre; application rates/MPH; and Fl. oz. of product/acre. In addition add the statement "Consult the previous chart for application rates" at the end of the paragraph under the same subheading.

- h. The statement on the front panel regarding trained personnel must be revised to read as follow:

For Application Only By Public Health Officials and Trained Personnel of Mosquito Abatement Districts and Other Mosquito control Programs, etc...

3. Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
