by giving an emetic such as 2 tablespoonfuls of table  
salt in a glass of warm water; repeat until vomit  
fluid is clear, then give 2 tablespoonfuls of baking  
soda in a glass of warm water.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Active ingredient is a metabolic  
stimulant. SYMPTOMS: Excessive fatigue, sweating,  
thirst and fever. Treat symptomatically.
