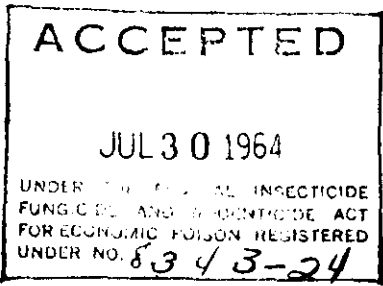

should receive a second application.
