This material, when applied with hand or power dusting equipment, will kill adult drosophila present at time of application and when thoroughly applied to the products listed below will greatly reduce egg deposition.

FRUITS: Apples, Blackberries, Boysenberries, Currants, Dewberries, Grapes, Loganberries, Peaches, Pears, Plums, Prunes (fresh).

VEGETABLES: Melons, Tomatoes - Dust containers thoroughly as soon after picking as possible. Also thoroughly dust loads after they have been assembled. Crops that are held for 20 hours after harvest should receive a second application. Consult local Agricultural Authorities for specific information as to timing, number and rates of applications which will vary with local conditions.
